


OVERVIEW OF STATE PROGRAM



The ND Career Builders Scholarship & Loan Repayment program is a tool for business to recruit and retain talent in high-need and emerging occupations in the state. This unique partnership provides \$1 of state funds for each \$1 of private-sector matching funds, up to a total of \$17,000 per recipient! The high-need and emerging occupations list is reviewed annually to determine qualifying positions. Individuals can receive a scholarship on the front end, loan repayment on the back-end, or both, for their commitment to the state to fill one of the high-need occupations.

CCJDA MATCHING PROGRAM

- CCJDA will provide qualifying for-profit businesses a grant totaling 50% of the businesses required match not to exceed \$4,250 per ultimate recipient
- CCJDA will provide qualifying non-profits a grant totaling 80% of the businesses required match not to exceed \$6,800 per ultimate recipient
- Grant goes to the business to be used for their match to the state program, no grants will be given directly to individuals
- Amount is distributed over a 3-year period, ultimate recipient must sign an agreement with the business to stay for three years
- Applicant businesses must have no active judgements against them and must be current on all Cavalier County Property Taxes
- The job position must be located in Cavalier County
- Program is first come first serve and is capped at \$25,000 annually
- Each application is subject to approval by CCJDA Board
- Contingent upon being approved for the North Dakota University
 System Career Builders Program
- Business must have an ultimate recipient/student identified

Companies who participate will:

- Ensure the participants meet state guidelines for program
- Make the agreed upon private donation to the ND Career Builders
 Program at the end of each year of successful employment
- Offer full-time employment with competitive wages once the qualifying applicant is hired and met the guidelines

Students/Employees who participate will:

- Have been issued a diploma/degree in the eligible high demand career fields required by the NDUS Career Builder program OR meet the agreed upon program requirements to enroll in the designated college and maintain GPA requirements
- Submit to a background check and a drug screening, if required by the company or college
- Live and work in Cavalier County region for 3 years
- Sign agreement to remain employed with the business for 3 years
